Forward typing and reverse typing: The two most common tests used in the blood bank are the forward typing and reverse typing tests. Forward typing uses commercial antisera (anti-A and anti-B) and patient red blood cells. A suspension of 2-5% patient RBCs are made and antisera is added to individual tubes.
