The other most important note for determining the quality of a chord is the seventh. The seventh of the note C is the note B. The minor seventh of the note C is the note Bb.

Most rock and pop songs use a mixture of major and minor piano chords. The third interval in a minor chord is called a " minor third. " The fifth interval in a minor chord is the same as in a major chord, the interval of a " perfect fifth. " Common minor piano chords include: C minor (Cm). C - Eb - G; C# minor (C#m). C# - E - G#; D minor (Dm). D - F - A

This time I ' ll introduce a new major seventh chord, Dmaj7. The Work. As a reminder, a major seventh chord is constructed of a major triad with a major seventh on top. So to build a Dmaj7 chord, take a D chord (D F# A) and add the major seventh (C#), as shown in Examples 1 and 2.

If we take the 1st note, 3rd note and 5th note (these are known as chord tones) of the Major scale, we get the Major chord: For example, using the A Major scale (A, B, C#, D, E, F#, G#), if we take the 1st note (A), the 3rd note (C#) and the 5th note (E), we get the A Major chord: A – C# – E = A Major.

Within chord progressions, contrast usually happens when differentiating between major and minor. Songs might feature a minor verse, and then switch to a chorus that ' s in the relative major key, like Carole King ' s classic hit " You ' ve Got a Friend " , the verse for which is in F minor, then switching to Ab major for the chorus.
